

## 2009 POOL RULES AND REGULATIONS

THE POOL IS OPEN FROM MEMORIAL DAY WEEKEND (SATURDAY) THROUGH LABOR DAY WEEKEND (MONDAY) WITH LIMITED HOURS AT THE END OF THE SEASON. WATCH YOUR BUILDING BULLETIN BOARDS FOR POOL NOTICES.

**DAILY HOURS: MONDAY – SUNDAY 10:00AM TO 8:00PM**

**The rules and regulations herein listed are for the protection and benefit of all, and to help insure safe and sanitary operation of the pool and its facilities. Your cooperation in abiding by these rules will afford pleasant relaxation and recreation for all concerned. Parents are requested to caution their children to observe all rules and to obey instructions. Violation of any of these rules will result in suspension of all pool area privileges. The pool guards on duty have full authority to ban anyone from the use of the pool for continued violations, misbehavior, drunkenness, etc.**

1. The pool will be open when the outdoor temperature is a minimum of 70 degrees, weather permitting. The pool will always be closed when it is lightening and/or raining, regardless of temperature. The closing of the pool will be left to the discretion of the pool guards.
2. Guests are allowed at the pool only when accompanied by a resident. There is no charge for your guest(s), but the lifeguard reserves the right to deny entry to the guests based on the occupancy of the pool upon their arrival.
3. Children under 10 years old must be accompanied by an adult (18 years or older) when in the pool area. The pool attendants are not babysitters! Unattended children will be sent home.
4. Infants and diaper-age children MUST wear diapers made specifically for water use (i.e. Huggies Swim Diapers). The lifeguard sells swim diapers for \$1 each for your convenience.
5. NO FOOD will be allowed in the pool area. Water will be allowed in clear plastic bottles only. We will have garbage cans outside the gate for you to dispose of your garbage. This is a DuPage County Health Department restriction.
6. Only those with swimwear will be permitted in the pool. All apparel worn in the pool must be swimsuit material. It must be clean and sanitary. Men and boys—SWIM TRUNKS; Women and girls—SWIMSUITS. Thong bathing suits, cutoffs, jeans, etc. are NOT permitted.
7. Hair shoulder length or longer must be secured with a cap or elastic band.
8. All chairs or loungers are to be covered with towels before using oil, as it destroys plastic.
9. No ball playing will be allowed in the pool area. Rafts and plastic toys will be allowed at the discretion of the pool guards.
10. All personal belongings must be removed from the pool area after each visit.
11. No street footwear will be permitted on the concrete deck of the pool.
12. No running, shoving or dunking will be allowed.
13. No abusive language will be tolerated.
14. Chaise lounges cannot be reserved for longer than 15 minutes so that others may use them.
15. No towels or articles of clothing are to be hung on the railing around the pool.
16. Radios/music may be played softly at the lounge chairs or with headphones.
